



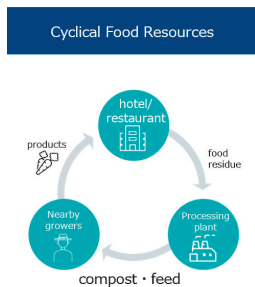
Policy for the future:

The Resorttrust Group receives many benefits from nature in its business activities, and we believe that nature enable us to provide a variety of services and products to our customers. We will strive to maintain and restore the relationship between our business and nature, including environmental changes associated with recreational facilities, procurement of materials and food essential for business operations, and the impact on surrounding communities. We aim to achieve a 40% reduction in GHG (Scope 1 and 2) by 2030 compared to 2019 (Group consolidated) and a 65.6% food waste recycling rate (Group alone) by 2027. Through these efforts, we will realize coexistence with nature and develop sustainable business activities.

<Examples of initiatives>

Cyclical Food Resources

The hotels operated by our group are installing facilities to convert food waste (food residue) generated in restaurants into compost and decompose it. We are also working to establish a “Cyclical Food Resources” in which we use compost derived from food residues generated at our hotels to provide crops grown by nearby growers.



Solar panel installation

As of October 2024, we have already installed solar power generation systems at all of our member resort hotel locations and golf courses in Japan, including on the rooftops of buildings and parking lots, with the aim of achieving carbon neutrality by 2050.
