



## Policy for the future:

1. Through surface modification technology, we will promote efforts to gradually reduce the negative impact on natural capital, including biodiversity and ecosystems, and increase the positive impact.
2. We will give more consideration than ever to climate change countermeasures, resource conservation, promotion of recycling, and reduction of environmentally hazardous substances throughout the entire supply chain.

## Specific examples of initiatives

At the Nihon Parkerizing Group, we have established the Policy on Social Contribution Activities, guided by which we engage in various activities together with people from local communities.

We engage in diverse activities tailored to local needs as part of our activities for contributing to local communities. At the same time, we strive to coexist in harmony and cooperate hand-in-hand with local communities, governments, and residents.

### [Social Contribution Activity Policy]

1. The Nihon Parkerizing Group will work to achieve the harmonious co-existence of each of its business sites in Japan and other countries and the local community in the area where they are located, thereby contributing to the sustainable development of local communities.
2. The Nihon Parkerizing Group will collaborate with local communities to engage in community-based activities, including environmental protection activities.
3. The Nihon Parkerizing Group will develop a corporate culture that will enable employees to participate in social activities voluntarily as members of the local community.

### [Representative activities]

1. In 2022, Thai Parkerizing planted 999 mangrove trees along the Bang Pu coast, which are expected to absorb approximately 10 tons of CO<sub>2</sub> per year. Mangrove forests not only contribute to reducing CO<sub>2</sub> emissions but also help prevent natural disasters.
2. The Kansai Factory, which manufactures surface treatment agents, participated in cleanup activities around Lake Biwa as part of its environmental beautification activities on Lake Biwa Day, July 1, 2024, contributing to fostering the lake's rich biodiversity.

We will respond to biodiversity in accordance with the framework to support the TNFD.
